School Readiness Attendance

A state of emergency has been declared by Governor Scott. School Readiness providers are entitled to reimbursement for the days they had to close due to the hurricane. Providers must enter the code "D" on both the Provider Attendance Roster and the parental signature sheet before submitting them in order to receive reimbursement for the closure days. If you have any questions, please e-mail your payment specialist.
